ITEM: Consideration and approval of Resolution 20250909.3 to adopt the tentative Fiscal Year 2026 Budget for the City of Panama City and Downtown Improvement Board.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This serves as the first public hearing under the TRIM Act for the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026 Budgets for the City of Panama City and Downtown Improvement Board. As discussed at the Budget Workshop conducted on July 22nd, 2025 adjustments were made in the General Fund to allocate additional funding to the MLK Recreation Center. Both the Environmental Services and Utilities Funds were budgeted to operate within the revenue limits set forth by the applicable rate study. No notable changes have been made to the Special Revenues, Debt, Marina, or Internal Services Funds. No changes have been made to the Downtown Improvement Board budget.

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION
OF FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 TENTATIVE BUDGET
FOR THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA, AND
THE PANAMA CITY DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30,
2026.**

Section 1. THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA, by this resolution does hereby adopt and approve the tentative budget for the City of Panama City, Florida, and the Panama City Downtown Improvement District for the year commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026.

Section 2. The total operating expenditure budget for the City of Panama City is \$136,529,775 (excluding interfund transfers). The total operating expenditure budget for the Downtown Improvement District is \$242,640.

Section 3. The tentative budgets for the City of Panama City and the Panama City Downtown Improvement District, which were approved by the adoption of this resolution, shall become effective October 1, 2025 for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2026 and taxing authority funds may be expended commencing October 1, 2025.
